
DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY



RoHS Declaration of Conformity (Directive 2011/65/EU)

The EU directive 2011/65/EU on the Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS 2) regulates the use of dangerous materials in devices and components. This directive as well as its respective implementation into national law are referred to by the abbreviation RoHS (Restriction of (the use of certain) hazardous substances).

The substances limited by RoHS to maximum permissible concentrations (Annex II of Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS 2)) are

1. Lead (Pb), 0,1%
2. Mercury (Hg), 0,1%
3. Cadmium (Cd), 0,01%
4. Hexavalent chromium (Cr+6), 0,1%
5. Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), 0,1%
6. Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE), 0,1%
7. Bis(2ethylhexyl)phthalate (DEHP), 0,1%
8. Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP), 0,1%
9. Dibutyl phthalate (DBP), 0,1%
10. Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP), 0,1%

We hereby certify, that Heinrich König & Co. KG does not use in their products any substances restricted by the RoHS Directive above the permissible maximum concentration values.
