

Intended Use

- Cleaning cartridge for the removal of lacquer and paint residue in spray devices after the processing of KING clear and covering lacquers.
- For flushing the spray device when changing the colour cartridge.
- For intermediate cleaning, when lacquer flow or spray pattern is irregular or after a longer period of standstill of the employed spray device.

Characteristics

- Contains solvents.
- Free of aromatic compounds.
- High cleaning power.
- Dries rapidly.

Application Notes

Before opening the KING, always disconnect the device from the compressed air supply while pushing the sliding ring on the quick coupling upwards and then disconnecting the hose from the device. After having opened the KING, remove colour cartridge vertically upwards (KING spray nozzle upwards).

Remove cap of the cleaning cartridge and slide the cartridge vertically upwards into the KING (KING spray nozzle upwards) – please see Krautzberger instructions page 17. The guide pins in the KING prevent the inserted cartridge from twisting.

IMPORTANT: The cartridge is correctly installed, when a click (locking) is heard.

Clean the spray device by flushing until pure cleaning solution emerges. Then, as described above, disconnect from compressed air supply and remove cartridge.

Now, insert a new colour cartridge and hermetically re-install the mounting sleeve, or, in case of non-use, close KING until next use by screw fastening the cap.

Cartridges are non-refillable.

Do not allow solvents to come into contact with gaskets, as these would swell or rather become brittle. Working pressure 0.5-2.0 bar.

Coverage: 1x equipment cleaning
Shelf life: minimum 2 years
(stored at room temperature, in un-opened original container)
